Are you getting enough sleep? Recent research suggests that most people sleep less than they should. If you fall asleep in less than five minutes then you need more sleep.

People in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries used to sleep nine and a half hours a night because they went to bed when it was dark. The electric light bulb changed that. Today, people try to do more and more in a day, and many feel the thing they can give up is sleep. If you need extra sleep, you have problems remembering things and find it difficult to make decisions or think clearly. Accidents also happen because sleepy people make mistakes and many factory accidents occur late at night.

Some people need more sleep than others, but for most people about seven to nine hours a night is enough. If you need an alarm clock, or if you feel sleepy in class, sleep an extra thirty to ninety minutes a night. Perhaps you will feel a lot better and your marks will improve!
